

INTERNET ACCEPTABLE USE REGULATION

Internet access will be available to students who qualify as result of participation in an orientation or training course or who can otherwise demonstrate Internet searching skills. Students will be expected to use the network in a considerate and responsible manner. The student's signature and the signature of a parent of legal guardian on the Acceptable Use Agreement are required before Internet access will be provided. Using the school's Internet connection without having a signed Acceptable Use Agreement on file is a violation of school rules. ***The use of the school's Internet connection is a privilege, not a right. Inappropriate use will result in a cancellation of those privileges.***

The user is expected to accept and follow rules of network etiquette and responsible behavior which includes but is not limited to the following:

1. Do not write or send messages that are abusive, harassing or make false or derogatory statements about others. Observe common courtesy in all electronic communication.
2. Do not swear, use vulgarities or other inappropriate language.
3. Transmission of obscene materials either to or from the school's computers is prohibited. Sending or receiving offensive messages or pictures will result in immediate suspension of privileges.
4. Do not reveal the personal address or phone number of yourself or other students.
5. Do not communicate any credit card number, bank account number, or any other financial information.
6. Electronic mail is not guaranteed to be private. People who operate the system do have access to all mail. Inappropriate messages can result in suspension of privileges.
7. Do not download any program or file from the Internet onto a school computer or load or install any program from a diskette or CD-ROM onto a school computer without permission.
8. Vandalism of software, hardware or another person's data will not be tolerated and will result in loss of privileges and other disciplinary action.
9. Do not download or copy software or information that is copyrighted. This is a violation of copyright laws.
10. Documents and other information accessed via the Internet which are used in compiling reports, term papers, etc. must be cited with a proper bibliographic reference. Not to do so constitutes plagiarism and will be disciplined as such.

The school reserves the right to monitor student communications over the computer network. Violation of any of the above mentioned rules and responsibilities will result in a loss of access and many result in other disciplinary or legal actions. A copy of these regulations is posted in every Internet access area.
