## **DRIVE 4UR SCHOOL DETAILS**

**How can you help All Saints earn up to \$6,000 during our Drive 4UR School event on Saturday, May 5th at St. Mary's Campus, 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.?**

Before you read any further, please note this is NOT a buying or selling event. Every driver who is 18 years of age, holds a valid drivers license, and can provide an address is eligible to test-drive a car on that day. Each test-drive earns the school \$20.00. In order for you and your spouse to each earn \$20.00, you must have two different addresses. For example, if you have a camp or own another property, one could use their home address and the spouse could use the camp address. This event is open to extended family members as well. We need 300 drivers to earn the maximum \$6,000.00 for our school. Every person who test-drives a car will also receive one entry into a drawing for a big screen TV!

In addition to the Drive 4UR School event, we will also have a truck/auto show where there will be a number of trucks, fancy cars, and emergency vehicles. There will also be a craft fair going on in the St. Mary's church hall with 20 plus vendors selling their wares. The eighth grade class will also be sponsoring a car wash and bake sale.
